Bryce Thompson HBCU Scholarship

Deadline: December 27, 2020

To be eligible for this \$10,000 scholarship, you must apply and eventually enroll in a Historically Black College and University (HBCU).

7Shifts Culinary Scholarship

Deadline: December 31, 2020

This \$1,000 scholarship is open to students interested in pursuing certification in Culinary Services or a related field.



<u>Automotive Women's Association</u> <u>Scholarship</u> Deadline: January 9, 2021

This \$2,500 scholarship requires you to maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA during your last year in high school. In addition, you must have been admitted to a college or university.

APIA Scholarship

Deadline: January 14, 2021

This scholarship provides scholarships to. underserved Asian Pacific Islander American (APIA) students. Awards can range from \$2,000 (single issue) to \$20,000 (multiple year). Visit the website for additional applicant requirements.



DECA Student Scholarship

Deadline: January 15, 2021

To be eligible for this award you must be a Senior attending a DECA member HS (which EHS is!). You must also planning to attend college in Fall 2021. The awardee will receive \$3,000.



<u>C-2 Scholarship</u> Deadline: January 30, 2021

To be eligible for this award you must have a 3.2 unweighted GPA. You must submit an essay (between 500-750 words) on overcoming challenges of COVID-19. The winner will receive a free diagnostic SAT/ACT test, free assessment, and 10 free hours of C-2 education courses.
