Georgian Court University is a private, Catholic university. Located in Lakewood, NJ, GCU is just minutes away from the Jersey Shore. This institution was founded and operated as a women's college and became co-ed in 2013.

GCU boasts of a 13:1 student to professor ratio, which is perfect for students looking for smaller and personal classes. A class of 25 students is considered large to them!

GCU has student futures in mind. All students are **required** to complete an internship by the time they graduate. In fact, most students have at least two. The experience gained will allow them to be able to make connections with employers very early on and prepare for the professional world.

A unique major offered here is Latino Business Studies, which focuses on building a foundation in business, while polishing your Spanish skills in a Spanish building environment.

GCU has a Priority deadline of **November 15** and is rolling after that date, which means that you can still apply! Even better: you don't have to pay the application fee!

Path to Pro Scholarship program

Deadline: December 31, 2021

Open to current 12th graders. This \$2,000 scholarship is awarded to students who plan on attending an accredited building construction trade college or postsecondary program in the US.

Ron Brown Scholarship Program

Deadline: January 9, 2022

This \$40,000 scholarship (broken down into \$10,000 each year) is open to current seniors. The scholarship is seeking applicants who are Black/African American and are interested in public service, community engagement, business entrepreneurship, and global citizenship.

Avomeen STEM Scholarships

Deadline: April 1, 2022

Avomeen offers two scholarships for students pursuing majors in STEM:


- Women in STEM (\$2,500)
